The incentives shorten the payback on your energy efficiency investments and help improve your company's bottom line. BOC GRADUATE INCENTIVE – \$200 for each employee who earns the BOC credential and submits an ESS Application for Service and W9 form for an approved and executed energy efficiency project to Seattle City Light.*

* TERMS & CONDITIONS: The application must be submitted within 12 months of earning the BOC certification. All projects are subject to approval by Seattle City Light. Proposed projects can be based on a class project. Limit one award per BOC graduate up to the first 5 graduates in a given course location. Total awards to be limited by funding availability.

Seattle City Light's Energy Smart Services program is available to commercial businesses, manufacturing plants, institutions and government facilities on the Medium General Service rate and larger. HOW TO SUBMIT BOC TUITION REBATE AWARD APPLICATION

Send completed **BOC Tuition Rebate Award Application** and **Energy Smart Services Application** to Seattle City Light. Once all materials are received, you or your facilities manager will be contacted by a Seattle City Light Energy Management Analyst to discuss your project and schedule a site visit. The BOC tuition rebate award will be paid at the time the contract is accepted by both parties. The graduate's name and the BOC program will be noted on the check stub. Ultimate dispersal of the BOC graduate incentive to the graduate is between the employee and their employer.
